FRED BERETTA – FLIGHT 1549 SURVIVOR

Fred is a Divine Mercy survivor of the ill fated US Airway Flight that miraculously crash landed in the Hudson River with zero fatalities on January 15, 2009. Fred had been on a one day business trip to New York and sat in seat 16A, just behind the left engine. “We were climbing out and just a minute or so into the flight I heard the impact of the bird strikes and then the explosion in the left engine.” As a private pilot, he once realized the second engine was also not functioning and things became quite tense. Fred really thought there was a good chance he and others on board the flight would die. Fortunately, he asked God to be merciful to all on board and was thankful that he prayed the Divine Mercy Chaplet the day before his trip. Miraculously, all 155 people on board survived. “The odds were not with us, but God clearly was.” Come and hear Fred’s fascinating story.

ANNIE KARTO

After much heartache and brokenness as a young woman, Annie Karto discovered the healing Mercy of God. A Catholic singer/songwriter and inspirational speaker, Annie Karto hopes to stir the flame in the Catholic Church through the power of God’s great gift of music by sharing her passion through song. 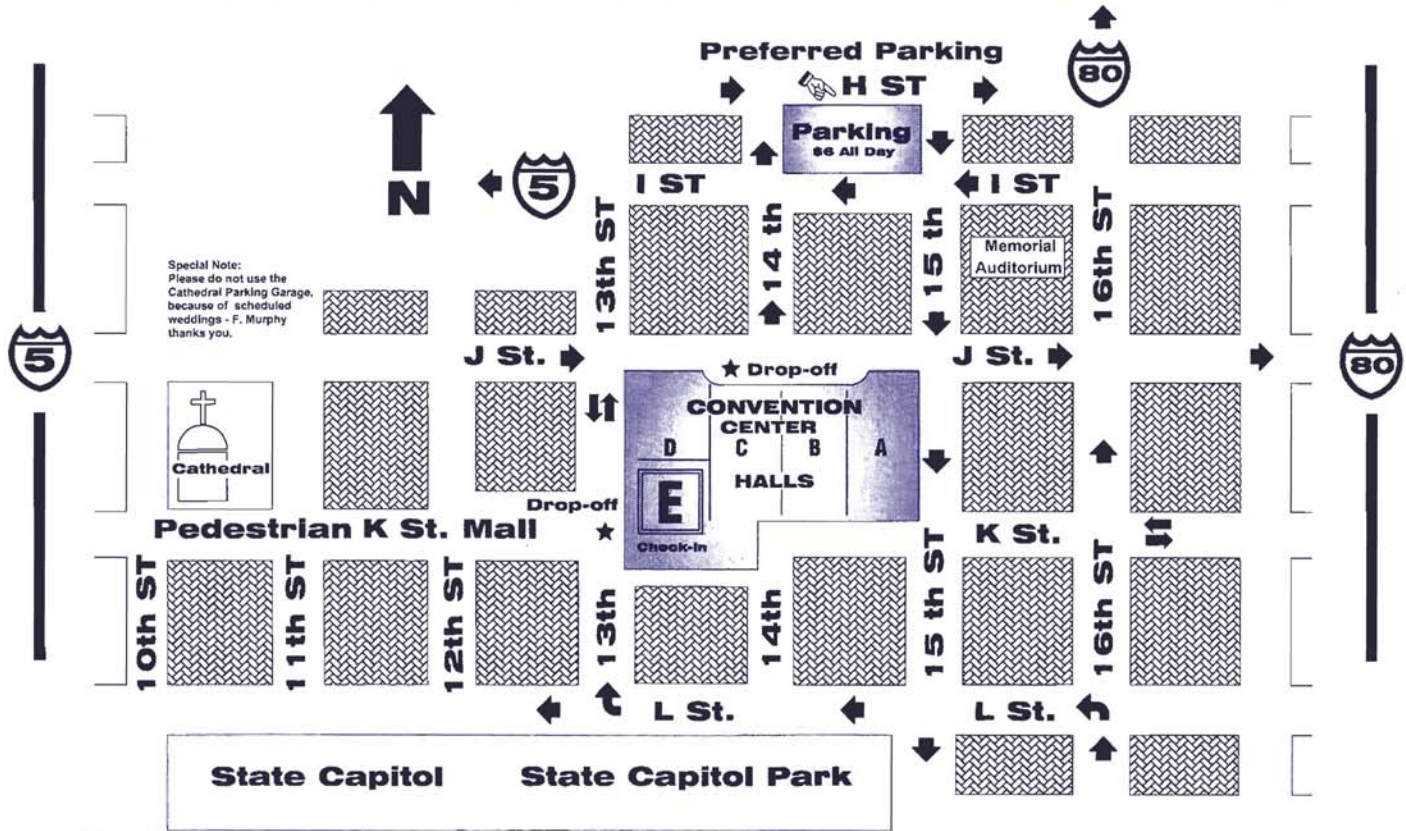
