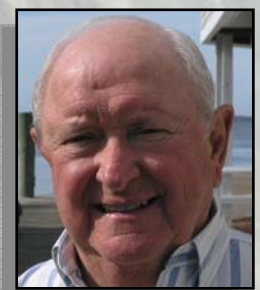

March to the Capitol to pray for Life and Mercy will happen during the lunch hour.

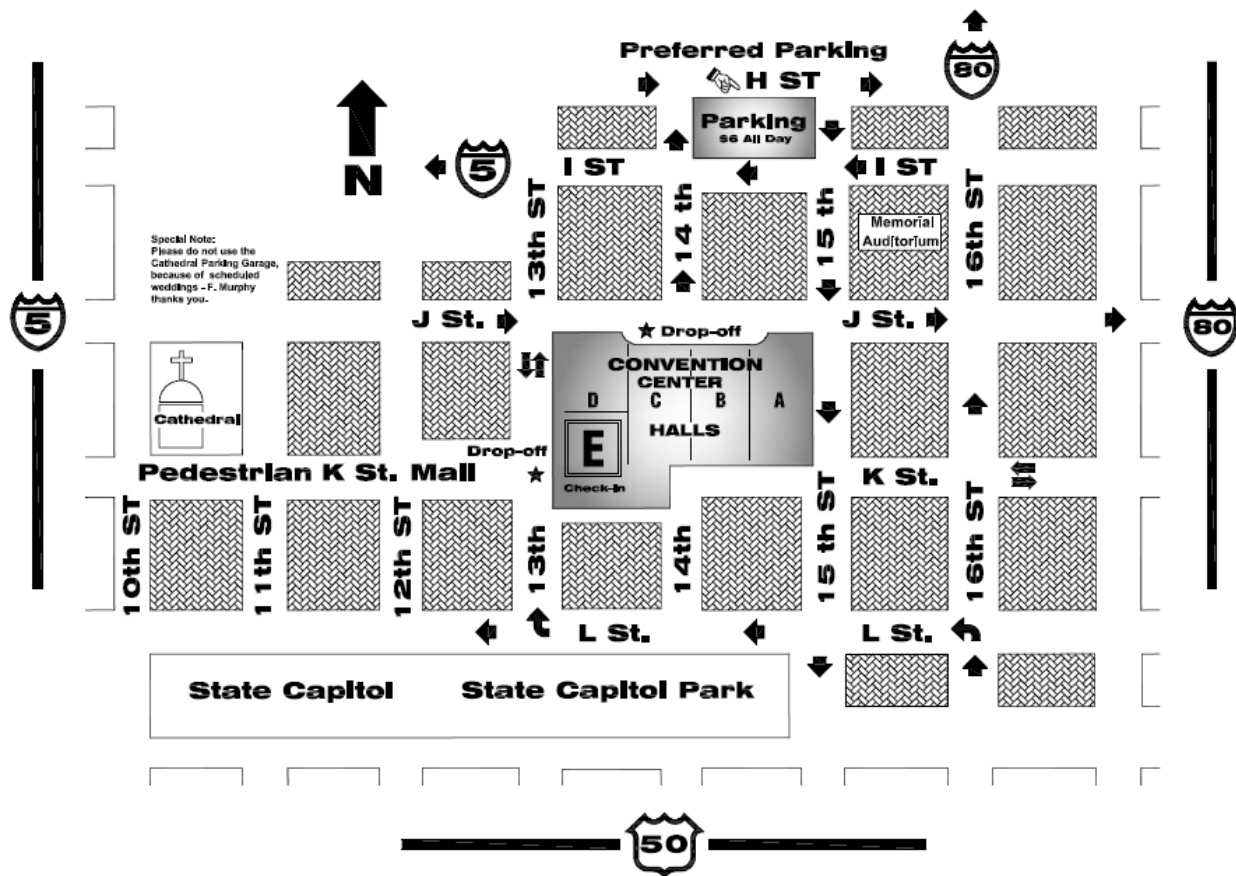
Veneration of the Divine Mercy image with Br. Stanley will be after the 4:45 mass.
